

Price Later Contract

- A price later contract allows the producer to establish a final pricing at a later date. Very similar to open storage.
- Payment is made in full when grain is priced.
- Upon delivery, title of the grain passes to the buyer.
- Price later is not open storage or a warehouse receipt.

A price later contract will be issued after delivery is complete. It must be signed and returned immediately to meet the requirements of the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture.

A Service Fee will be assessed as market conditions warrant. 2015-16 fees:

Corn: 3 cents/bu/mo till Sept. 30, 2016; then effective rate. No Rollover Fee

Beans: 4 cents/bu/mo till Sept 30, 2016, then effective rate. No Rollover Fee.
